Janea A. Scott, a Commissioner at the California Energy Commission (CEC), will participate at the Chicago Ideas Week (CIW), and will join Assistant Secretary of the Navy, Dennis McGinn on a panel about the United States Military's role in fighting climate change and its impact on broader energy policies and markets.
