Section 2: Describe the entity's business activity or its nature and interests.

Biofuels Congress 2017, Conference Series, LLC, is an amalgamation of Open Access Publications and worldwide international science conferences and events. Established in the year 2007, Conference Series has organized more than 3,000 international conferences across the globe, where knowledge transfer takes place through speaker presentations, workshops, symposia, and exhibitions.

ClimateWorks Foundation was established in 2008 to help philanthropy meet the challenge of global climate change. ClimateWorks has given hundreds of grants worldwide, helped build greater capacity in key regions, and collaborated with a network of partners to support research, policy advocacy, outreach and public engagement, all with the aim of reducing the emissions that cause climate change.

Section 3.2: Specific description of the payment and its agency purpose and use.

Janea A. Scott, a Commissioner at the California Energy Commission (CEC), was an Organizing Committee member and gave a key note presentation at the *Biofuels Congress 2017* in London, United Kingdom. The Biofuels Congress 2017 serves as an international platform designed to promote knowledge and innovation exchange on current and emerging topics related to biofuels and bioenergy. Commissioner Scott had the opportunity to engage with the world's leading policy makers, companies, and researchers to relay California's perspectives on the role of incentive programs, infrastructure, research, and development.

Commissioner Scott also joined with key members of ClimateWorks to participate in meetings at Transport & Environment in Brussels, Belgium. T & E is a network of 53 organizations working to promote a transport policy across Europe based on the principals of sustainable development. She and the representatives from ClimateWorks also met with the European Parliament. The meetings were an opportunity for Commissioner Scott to shed light on different forms of advanced alternative fuels, especially electricity and biofuels from wastes and residues, their sustainability, and their place in the European policy framework.
