**NOTICE OF PROPOSED AWARD (NOPA)**

On February 4, 2015, the California Energy Commission released a competitive solicitation to fund technical assistance for the EPIC Program. Up to \$3 million in Electric Program Investment Charge (EPIC) funding is available to provide technical assistance activities.

The Energy Commission received one proposal by the due date of March 19, 2015. The proposal was screened, reviewed, evaluated and scored using the criteria in the solicitation. The proposal passed the screening, evaluation, and minimum scoring requirements.

The attached "Notice of Proposed Award" identifies the Bidder that is recommended for funding by Energy Commission staff and includes the recommended funding amount and score. The total amount recommended is \$3 million, of which \$1 million is immediately available with the remaining balance of \$2 million being contingent upon approval of future fiscal year funds and program plans.

Funding of the proposed project resulting from this solicitation is also contingent upon the approval of the project at a publicly noticed Energy Commission Business Meeting and execution of a contract agreement. If the Energy Commission is unable to timely execute a contract with the Bidder, the Energy Commission, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to cancel or otherwise modify the pending award.
