FERC RP06-407 GTN General Rate Case	On June 30th, GTN proposes at FERC cost of service, rate increase of 70%	FERC Order of 12/21/06, makes some initial determinations, denies summary judgment on GTN risk for stranded capacity, sets issues for hearing and technical conference.
FERC RP06-614 Transwestern General Rate Case	Transwestern proposes at FERC a 50% rate increase in CA rates, gas quality specs	Settlement talks occurring.
