RESOLUTION NO. 13-125

APPROVING AND ADOPTING A RENEWABLE ENERGY RESOURCES PROCUREMENT PLAN FOR THE HERCULES MUNICIPAL UTILITY IN COMPLIANCE WITH CALIFORNIA **ENERGY COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, the City of Hercules (City) maintains a publicly owned utility known as the Hercules Municipal Utility (HMU) which distributes electricity to residents and businesses in a portion of the City of Hercules; and

WHEREAS, the Hercules City Council has the authority to adopt and implement the requirements of state law applicable to the HMU; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2011, the Governor of California signed the California Renewable Energy Resources Act (SBX1 2), which requires all energy service providers, including publicly owned utilities, to procure 20% renewables over the 2011-2013 period, 25% renewables by 2016, and 33% renewables by 2020 and thereafter, and

WHEREAS, the California Energy Commission (CEC) has issued regulations effective October 1, 2013 implementing the provisions of SBX1 2 for publicly owned utilities; and

WHEREAS, the CEC regulations require the adoption of a Renewable Energy Resources Procurement Plan that complies with the CEC's October 1, 2013 regulations by November 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, City staff has developed the attached Hercules Municipal Utility Renewable Energy Resources Procurement Plan, to comply with the CEC's October 1, 2013 regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hercules as follows:

1. That the City Council hereby approves and adopts the Hercules Municipal Utility Renewable Energy Resources Procurement Plan (Plan), attached hereto as Exhibit A, and the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to implement and administer the Plan.
